Logo Design competition for a start-up was organized for classes IX to X on the 23rd of July 2022.

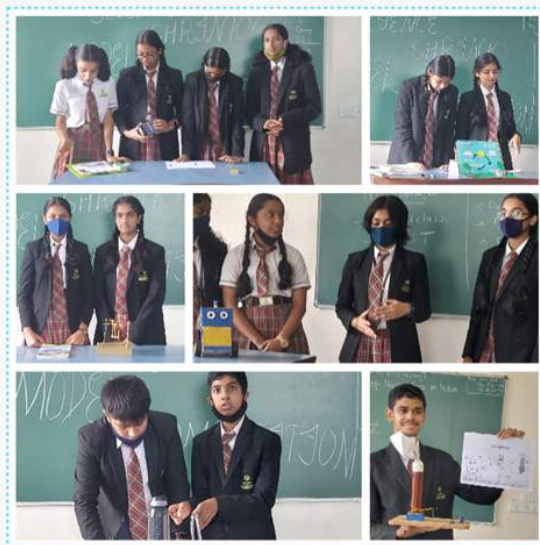

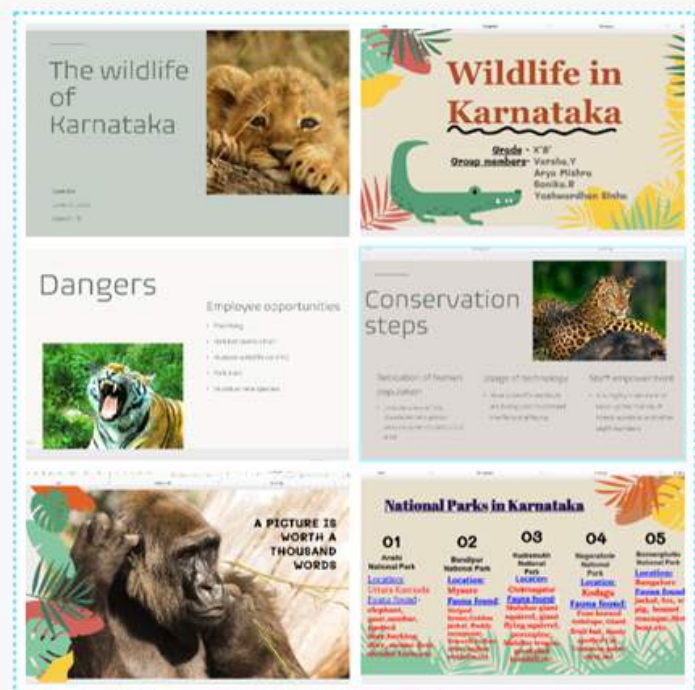
Achiever's Meet for the month:

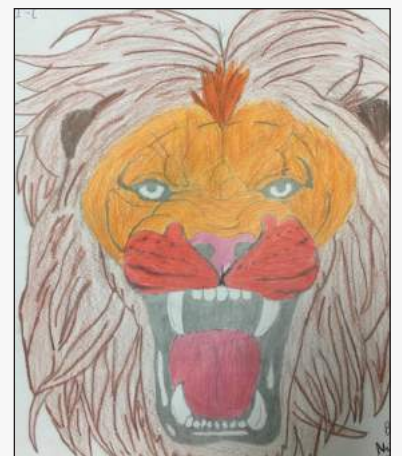
For many times I forget to say "Thank you."

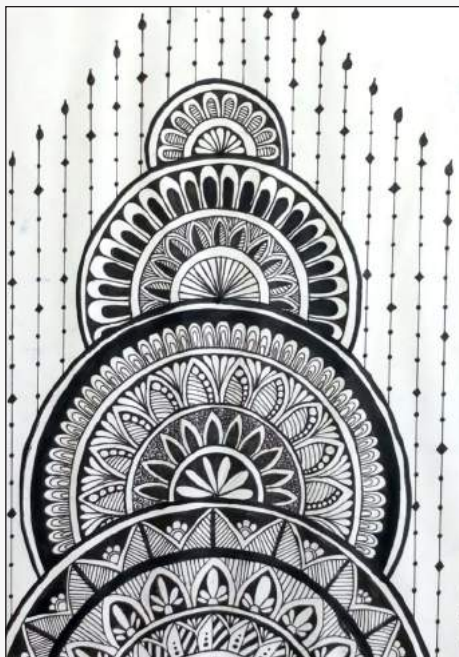
**Most importantly keep all electronic devices away from** unless it is necessary so that you don't get yourself distracted.
